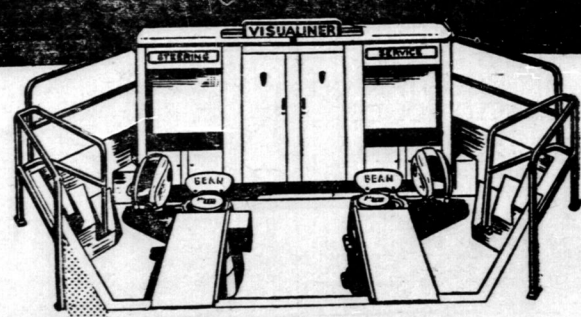

FARMERS TO BUILD MEAT PROCESSING PLANT

Plans for a farmer-owned meat processing plant were announced today by Raymond and Anderson of Waterford. Mr. Anderson is a Director of the Haldimand Federation of Farmers' Allied Meat Enterprises.

The organization building the plant, the Haldimand Federation of Farmers' Allied Meat Enterprises, has many local farmers as FAME members.

The processing plant, the first of a proposed series of seven, will be located on a 100 acre property near Ford. Mr. Anderson is a Director of the Haldimand Federation of Farmers' Allied Meat Enterprises.

The property fronts on Highway 401, just east of the cloverleaf of 401 and Highway 97, and has excellent advertising exposure. Arrangements have been made for the purchase of the property from the owner, Arnold Rife. Water drilling will start immediately, the local FAME chairman said.

The plant will be the largest of the seven, and will perform a complete processing, curing and canning operation. It will handle livestock products and later will complete meat processing operations begun in some of the other projected FAME plants.

The seven plants will be located throughout Ontario. Designers of the plant are Toronto architects, Omack, McMurtry and Fisher, in consultation with pack house design specialists, Troy and Stalder, Omaha, Nebraska. The construction have conferred since April with the Ontario Water Resources Commission on design of the sewage system and now have drawn plans for final approval. Tenders for construction will be called in the near future.

Welcoming FAME to North Dumfries township, Reeve Floyd Becker said the municipal council will construct an access road into the plant.

Research indicates that two-tonne cars are easier to see, and may therefore be slightly less liable to involve pedestrians in accidents. At 60 M.P.H. a two-tonne car becomes visible to another motorist half a second later than a solid colour vehicle. However, the Ontario Safety League hopes that no one will get the idea that colour combinations can be an acceptable substitute for careful driving.
