is, we can see no reason why the next Parliament should not be productive to the public good. It is interesting to note some of the opinions held by those who are mixed up in political affairs. One of these is Douglas Fisher, M.P. for Port Arthur. Fisher flashed into the news back in 1957 when he unseated the Great C. D. Howe. His win was not popular in too many quarters but since that time he has been building a considerable measure of respect for his forthrightness and self confidence.

Fisher has been an advocate of higher pay for M.P.s. claiming it is impossible on the present salary to exist. In 1957 he accepted a writing assignment with the Toronto Telegram and his columns are a feature of that newspaper.

Commenting on the results of the election he expressed admiration for the fighting qualities of John Diefenbaker. He says he finds it hard to congratulate the Liberals in view of the superb support that party received from the Press and still failed to obtain a clear majority. In this connection, he continues, it makes one reflect on the political wisdom of the one-sided violence these publishers have dispensed.

Most interesting to us is his comment on the defeat of Hazen Argue (former NDP) and Patrick Leonard (Red) Kelly, with a majority of more than 17,000 votes in West York, who established his seat. He indicates that the voters of that area will be over in another week. This is not going to make his hockey fans happy but in that game a man cannot go on forever. We hope that his Parliamentary career is equally illuminating as his Hockey career.

THIS WEEK (intended for last issue) The Ontario government's proposed pension act should be drastically revised, the Canadian Auto Workers (CAW) council was told Sunday. Fat Smith, chairman of the Ontario Federation of Labour, said all unions in the province must support the Ontario Federation of Labour in getting the act changed. "The way this thing is now it has more holes in it than a sieve," he said. He also said the government should be the central agency. The government announced that it would make it compulsory for employers with 15 or more employees to establish a minimum pension scheme. Employees who change jobs would not lose pension benefits.

ATTACK SCHOOL PLAN Ontario school board trustees and teachers have criticized the municipal affairs department should exercise more control over county councils. He said this would be one of the aims of the federation. The first should be to seek provincial guarantees of the municipal council's rights to nominate candidates in rural elections and to assure their voting rights.
