RATH AT HARBWOOD
Ludwig Heimrath of Toronto, driving a 1954-1955 Porsche, won three events, including the main 50-lap race, at the London Automobile Sports Club's races here Saturday.
Heimrath lapped all but one car—a 1950 Ford driven by Grant Clark of Toronto—in the 50-lap race, and finished second, ahead of L. L. MacLachlan of London, who drove a 1954 Ford.
A crowd of 1,000 turned out for the first public race meeting of the season in Ontario.
Heimrath dominated the first lap, leading at the end of the race.
At the mid-way mark Heimrath had lapped all but Clark and Comstock in the 18-car field. He lapped Comstock on the 27th lap to win by 7 1/2 seconds over Clark at an average speed of 86.3 mph.
Heimrath's fastest lap of the day, one minute 17 seconds, stands as the track record.
More than 200 racing enthusiasts attended a banquet at the Jarvis Women's Institute in the Community Hall on Saturday evening.
