We have reason to believe the proper steps are being taken to achieve the goal of waterworks and sewage and we fervently hope that every citizen of Jarvis will lend his or her full support both morally and financially to bring it about.

The row of trees and brush on the south side has been cleared out and the additional six acres of land, acquired by the Lions Club is now open to view. Imaginative planning will ultimately create a most attractive addition to our park area and in years to come those responsible will have a memorial to their efforts.

Why do so many people in North Walpole believe that a minority group of ratepayers should have no opportunity to request a fair and reasonable school system for their children? A centralized system has been needed for many years in this area. No major repairs or improvements have been made, particularly at S.S. No. 6 S.S. No. 11, and S.S. No. 19 for at least eight years.

Although we are a minority group, we pay our school taxes for the upkeep and the building of schools, and for the education of all the children in the North Walpole School Area. We feel we are regarded as second-class citizens who must either make-do with the outmoded and unsafe facilities available in these sections, or those of us who are in sections where the need for better educational facilities is desperate are being discriminated against; we are told our needs do not matter, we will get as little

as absolutely necessary and one of the trustees has warned members of Council that, when they presume to try to raise the standard of education and educational facilities in North Walpole, this will be "insisted". It seems to me there is a strong quality of dictatorship in the school situation in this area.

Even this petition of the Nobe people, which is being so nobly defended, is a form of dictatorship. Unless this section is allowed to dictate by their solid-bloc vote against any man interested in providing better school accommodations for the area) to the rest of the area that no central school could be built, the people there apparently feel they would withdraw from the area. Of course, the fair way when the Nobe people were so understandingly satisfied with the school situation in their section, would have been for the Nobe section to refrain from voting on any central school issue. This would have been the proper way to represent the section, or prevention of centralization. Then a true picture of the desires of the rest of the area could have been obtained. If the results had not met with their approval, they could then have withdrawn from the area, or worked out a compromise with the rest.

Since the interested members of Council knew that such a situation could not be in our democratic society (every ratepayer is entitled to vote, and that some action must be taken in the school question, the logical step to take was to allow Nobe to withdraw. Possibly further steps could have been taken to remedy the situation permanently. As long as the Nobe section remained in this area, the Nobe have and would have vetoed every decision to build a central school, through their solid-bloc vote.

For very different reasons I agree with the "four-man Nobe committee" that we, as ratepayers, do have a job to do on December 2nd, 1963, in time for the people who care for the future of our children and the future of North Wal-
