Allan Wins Decisive Victory In Haldimand-Norfolk

Hon. James N. Allan was re-elected member for the riding of Haldimand-Norfolk in the voting on Wednesday with the highest majority ever accorded him in the four elections he has contested. He added more than 200 votes to his 4,174 majority in the 1959 election. Significant in the returns was the support accorded the winner in the County of Norfolk where he had a majority of over 2,400 votes. This was more than double his majority in the 1959 contest.

John Cooper, the candidate for the Liberal party, polled nearly 9,800 votes which was an increase of about 1,000 over the Liberal candidate in the 1959 election. Despite the increased support for the Liberal candidate, Mr. Allan increased his overall majority. The winning candidate toured the riding as the results came in and spoke to supporters at a mass celebration at the Dunnville before appearing at a mass celebration at the McHenry Raceway at Kohler at the end of the evening.

Mr. Allan expressed his thanks to his supporters on each occasion and said he would do his best to serve the people of Haldimand-Norfolk for the next four years.
