Perhaps that is why I find it so profoundly shocking that these people at Nobex, who are quite satisfied with the facilities at their immediate vicinity, should first round by a one-run margin. 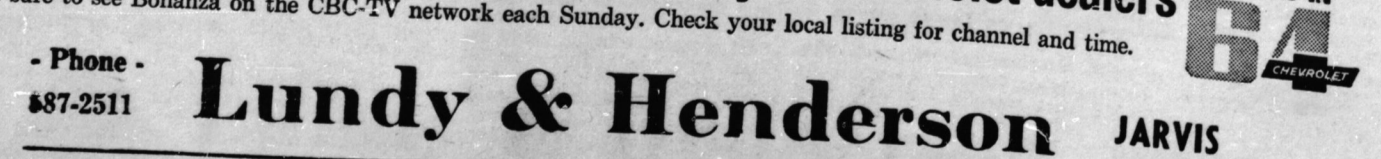
