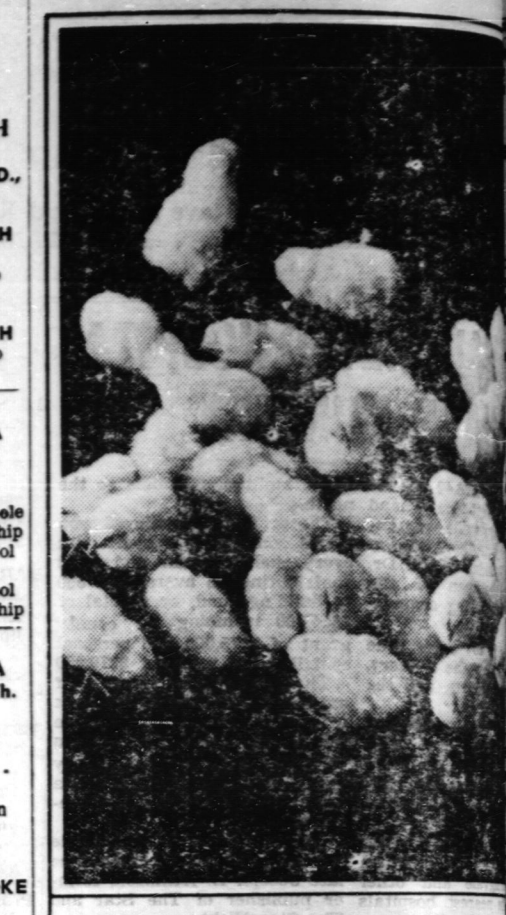

Your government is issuing Social Insurance Cards in place of the unemployment insurance cards that most employed people have had until now. The new numbers will help government to use office methods for greater efficiency in handling employment insurance, and also other social security as proposed pension plans.

For these reasons, you are invited to apply for your Social Insurance Number, even if you are not a contributor to the unemployment insurance plan.

IF YOU ARE AN EMPLOYEE your employer will give you an application form. Fill it out and return it to your employer promptly.

IF YOU ARE UNEMPLOYED and drawing unemployment insurance benefit you will complete an application form when you report to the U.I.C. in person by mail.

IF YOU ARE AN EMPLOYEE registered with the Commission, you will receive application forms from the Commission. If you are not registered with the Commission, get in touch with your local U.I.C. office so you may be sent to you. Distribute application forms to your employees, have them completed and return them promptly together, not individually, to the Commission.
