Hospital have ordered independent investigations into the death of a patient who died 13 days after an operation in which a surgical clamp was left in her body.
Mr. Cass said Friday circumstances surrounding the November 4 death of 23-year-old cancer patient Patricia Morgan indicate an inquest will be necessary, but said final decision will be left until all the facts are known.
The hospital's board of governors called a special meeting Friday and announced it will launch an immediate investigation into Miss Morgan's death and operating room procedures.
The inquest was sought by Metropolitan Toronto's chief coroner Dr. Morton Shulman who disclosed the surgical clamp had been left in Miss Morgan's body after a doctor had started to operate on her, was called away and replaced by another doctor. Hospital authorities have refused to disclose the name of the second doctor.
Dr. Kenneth A. Brown, 45, the doctor who started the operation of the "cancer mine," says the veteran of East General, he has not been permitted to use hospital facilities still officially on the staff of East General.
Miser Recouped
The Gord Eggers, freed Saturday from an underground trap that held him for 17 hours says he "won't go down again for 10 years of hardrock mining." "I'd intend to stay here," he said.
The 31-year-old father of six was reported in good condition in hospital after being rescued from a tiny hole in a cave-in in a working place near the 700-foot level of a mine near Atikokan, 140 miles west of Fort William.
The cave-in Friday night blocked much of the 80-ft drift in which Eggers was working. Timbers fell across a working shaft, and a rock fall blocked his escape route. Mr. Eggers was pinned by falling rock. The rescue operation was a major feat. It took 24 hours to reach the trapped miner and to dig out his escape route. He was rescued at 11 p.m. Saturday.
The rescue was the work of a team of men from the mine, and the work of the Ontario Department of Mines, which sent a rescue team to the mine.
