THE COMBINED School Boards of Jarvis, North and South Walpole held a third combined meeting on Monday night, notwithstanding new considerations that have arisen this year. There has been no change in the policy considerations of the Boards. At least, this is what a vote taken on Monday night would seem to indicate.

The vote taken among members of the three Boards on Monday night approved the building of a 10-room night-room school in the central area of South Walpole. The Board will continue to operate the Jarvis School.

This paper never meant to imply that it was the purpose of the Walpole Boards to close the Jarvis School. It was a matter of common sense. If two new, modern schools are built in Walpole Township and Jarvis, it would mean that the Jarvis school would become an antiquity in a relatively short time and that a full program of education would be provided for Jarvis students there would, of necessity, have to be in the rural school two miles and one-half away. It was logical to add to the old Jarvis School in preference to a new school, what would the transportation grants be?
