## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

**FRUIT RELISH**  
Serves 8-10. Crisp with cranberries; pleasing with pear

1 large orange  
1 cup canned Canadian pears, diced (choice of standard grade)  
2 cups raw cranberries  
¼ cup sugar  
2 tablespoons lemon juice  
1 ½ ounce package lemon-flavoured gelatin

Peel orange. Scrape off most of the white membrane. Put peel, pulp and cranberries through a food chopper using medium blade. Combine with pears and sugar. Prepare gelatin according to directions on package. Chill until thick as unbeaten egg white. Fold in cranberry and pear mixture. Pour into 1½ quart mold. Chill until firm.
