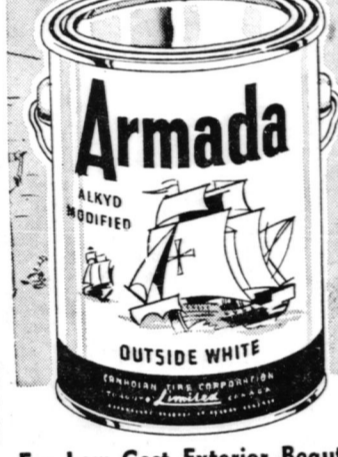

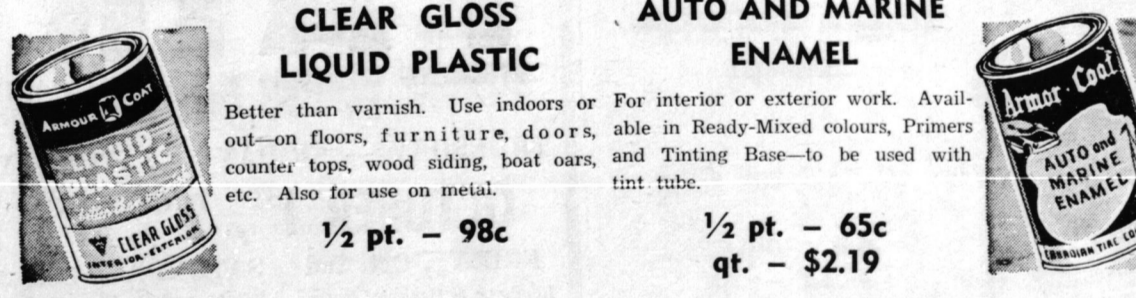

**NEW SERVICE FOR CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS**

Beginning September 1st the Dominion Drama Festival has announced that they have speakers available for meetings of organizations. The Dominion Drama Festival Central Office in Ottawa has announced the appointment of Mr. Ted M. Fielder as co-ordinator of the Speakers' Panel. Mr. Fielder told us today that meetings have begun to all organizations in Western Ontario of whom his office is aware.

Mr. Fielder said "We presently have eight top-flight people available in Western Ontario people who include senior officers of the Dominion Drama Festival and some of the best speakers in Ontario."

### THIS WEEK

Ontario Liberals meet Thursday in Toronto to choose a new party leader, among other scheduled activities.

Leadership since the resignation of John Wintermyer will see to select from the six or seven contenders for leadership honors.

Charles Templeton, 48, who "didn't even consider losing" in the Toronto Riverdale bye-election last week, would have been a strong contender for the top post. After the results of the byelection were announced, Mr. Templeton indicated he would not now run for party leadership. He later said he would reconsider his position when hundreds of supporters assured him of their backing.

But later he announced he would not campaign further and a "draft Templeton" group was formed at the weekend to indicate to the reluctant candidate that he had the necessary support to continue in the race.

Mr. Templeton came third in New Democratic Party candidate James Renwick. In the byelection last week other so-called Liberals who had been a Liberal, but were supported by Conservative Ivan Thrasler.

Certain contenders for leadership are Andrew Thompson, legislative member for Toronto; Doug Campbell, M.P.P. for Victoria North; M.P.P. Gordon Bell, M.P.P. for Hamilton; and J. E. Conroy, M.P.P. for Scarborough.

Conroy holds 77 seats, Liberals 23, and New Democrats eight.

**BRILLIANT MINES CASE**

The Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce has been ordered to pay Brilind Mines Ltd. \$800,000 plus about \$415,000 interest in an action arising from the 1957 sale of the Toronto-based company to New York businessmen.

The award was made by Mr. Justice Campbell Grant of the Supreme Court of Ontario. He ruled that the senior officers of the bank should have taken action when one of their branch managers became suspicious about a \$1,000,000 deal completed in his office after banking hours.

The deal involved Ben Smith, 50, of Toronto, who is appealing his January conviction and sentence of six years imprisonment for defrauding Brilind of \$800,000 in the transaction.

Smith and his brother, Harry, had a controlling interest in the company. Ben Smith received 600,000 Brilind shares having a market value then of 45 cents a share.

The New York men, Stanley Schomburg, 41, Sol R. Ranch, 43, and his brother Harold, 45, took only 16 hours to complete the transaction in two of the bank's branch offices. Extraordinary proceedings are in progress to bring them back for retrial on fraud charges.

Mr. Schomburg and Sol Ranch both have vanished — Camp Gazette (N.B.) Gazette.
