

We wish we could get this Beatlemania straightened out in our mind. Most writers tread lightly on the subject almost as if they can't see whether or not they were as nutty themselves in the days of their youth. Michael Allen is more forthright. He says the demented behaviour of teenagers during the recent visit of the Beatles disgraces the homes they live in and the schools they attend. One may conclude that the guidance instruction in conduct and the tuition they receive in school is deficient in discipline.

Mr. Allen goes on to say there is no excuse for unrestrained, idiotic display of

motionalism. It is an exhibition of license, and it is lastly and most vexatiously on the part of parents and teachers to dismiss these excesses in teenage behaviour on the ground that it is innocent and harmless. Lack of restraint, uncontrolled emotions, the unbridled indulgence of desires in teenagers can not be turned off like a tap. We see it manifested in sexual liberties, in disrespect for morality, for honor, for convention. We see it in the unprincipled striving for success, regardless of the means as long as it is not found out, and if one is found out the attitude seems to be that one was a fool to be so careless as to be discovered.

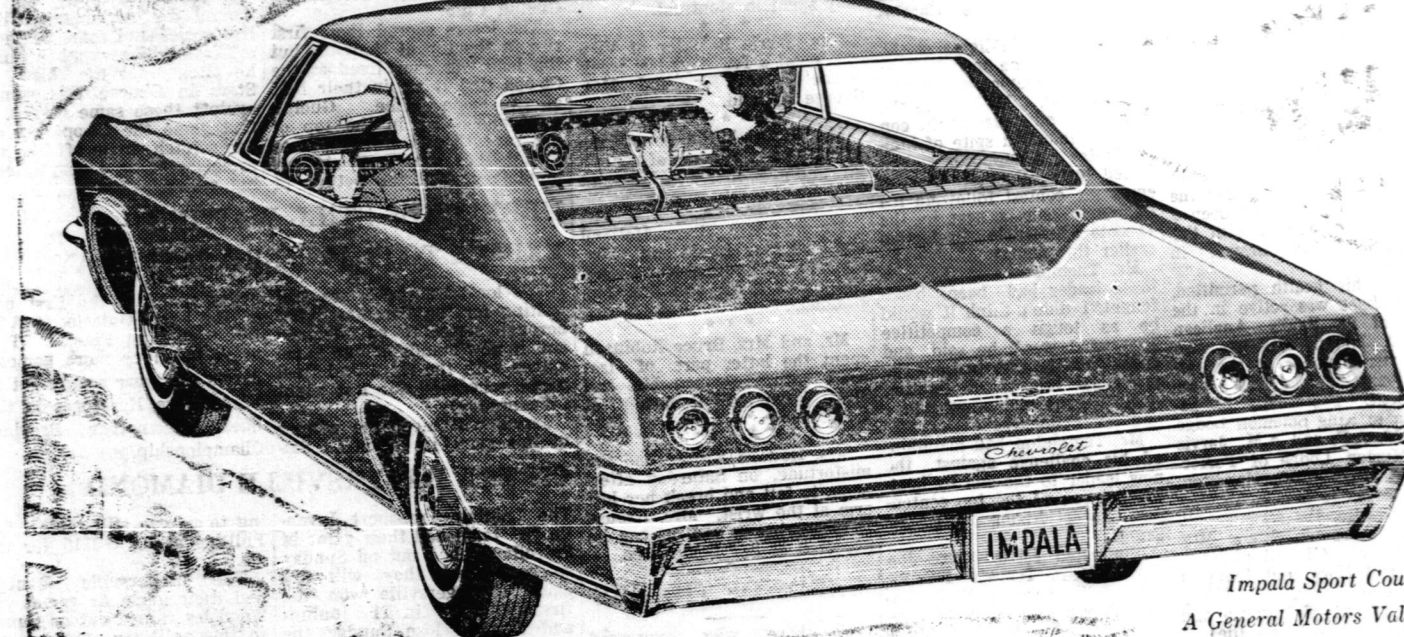
It is Mr. Allen's contention that self-expression has become licentious, and self-indulgence knows no restraint. He submits the parents and teachers are guilty. They fail to guide; they fail to inculcate values; they fail to impose discipline. We're going to cast our vote in favour of Mr. Allen's diagnosis.

The same thought can be followed in a recent statement of the Most Rev. Fulton J. Sheen, Auxiliary Bishop of New York. He wonders whether the world has not gone too far in its sympathy with the

criminal. Compassion is a admirable quality, says Bishop Sheen, but it needs to be intelligently guided. He says compassion is being twisted these days to mean "compassion for the Criminal, the bum, the breaker of the law," rather than compassion for their victims. Something the same was said about accident cases recently by Chief Justice McMurtry, when he retired after 20 years on the High Court of Ontario. "There is every reason why the criminal should receive every fair treatment and justice and an environment for rehabilitation. But there may be a danger that his victim becomes the forgotten person in it all.

We think it is about time we re-read the philosophy of Sir Wilfrid Laurier as stated in one of his last public speeches. He said: "As for you who stand on the threshold of life, with a long horizon ever open to the promptings of faith and the gentle influence of brotherly love. Be adamant against the haughty, be gentle and kind to the weak, be firm before adversity, be good report or ill, in victory or defeat, be so to live, so to strive, so to serve, as to do your part to raise ever higher the standard of life and living."
