During the coming days a great deal will be said and sung about the most joyous season of the year which we call Christmas. But actually Christmas is not so much an occasion for talk as it is an occasion for worship and reflection. It is an opportunity to be seized.

Someone has said that "part of the art of teaching lies in reminding people of that which they already know." Christmas needs nothing added to it. What is necessary is that we become aware of what lies at the heart of it.

The Apostle John has told us that the heart of Christmas is to be found in the Word made flesh. That which was made flesh in the beginning and came forth into the world of kindredness. But it was that kind of humanness that Christ took upon himself. Robert Herrick, the 17th century English poet puts it this way:
