The Municipal Council of the Township of Walpole met on this date, with members present: Mayor, Councillors, and various officials.

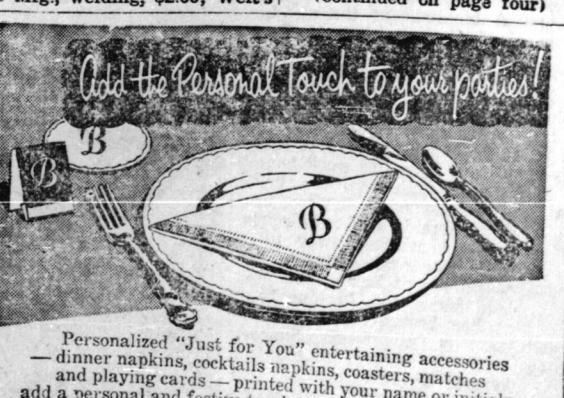
CHILD WELFARE LEAGUE WILL HOLD CONFERENCE
