PENNELL RUMORED TO

Larry Pennell, M. P. for Brant-Haldimand is rumored to succeed Justice Minister Luc-ien in the forthcoming Cabinet succeed Justice Minister Liteien in the forthcoming Cabinet
shuffle.

Mr. Pennell has been acting
Minister of Justice for some
weeks due to the illness of the
Minister. He has also carried
on the business of his own Department as Solicitor-General.

Mr. Pennell has taken on increased responsibility since his
election to the Commons in
1962 He was Parliamentary
assistant to the Minister of Finance before gaining his own
Cabinet Post early this year.
Shortly after assuming the
Post of Solicitor-General he
was named to help Revenue
Minister Benson and Post Master General Tremblay negotiate
with Postal employees when
they struck last August.

Speculation on Mr. Pennell's
promotion to the Justice Department is tempered by the
fact this post goes traditionally
to a French Canadian in Liberal Governments. There is
precedence for a change however since Louis St. Laurent
took Stuart Garson from the
Premiership of Manitoba to
make him Justice Minister and
Attorney General in 1948.
