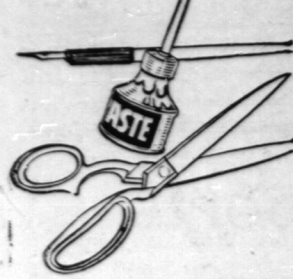


THIS WEEK

BMT WOUND UP A shareholders meeting in Stratford of British Mortgage and Trust Co. was held last week that the company lost between \$10,000,000 and \$15,000,000 as a result of the collapse of Atlantic Acceptance Corp. and its associated firms.

BMT officials said they would probably write off \$5,000,000 but hoped to recover at least \$2,000,000 on secured notes. The company is to be reorganized with Victoria and Grey Trust Co. of Lindsay. Shareholders' votes were nearly unanimously in favor of the merger. They will receive one share of BMT for every six shares of BMT held before which could have been sold in 1964 for \$40.
