One disease prevalent in dairy cattle that has given more trouble than any other during the past few years is "mastitis". When it occurs, not only is it costly to treat but the reduction in milk seriously cuts into the dairyman's pay-check. In addition to the regular treatments recommended by veterinarians to keep the disease in check, there are two new programs underway implemented by the Ontario Department of Agriculture to help fight the disease.

First of all, there is the Ontario Mastitis Control Program, and a dairyman has the opportunity to enroll his herd on the program for six months. Milk samples are taken from each guarter of the udders every 6 weeks, the mastitis or ganisms, if present, are identified, and a prescribed treatment is recommended. The cost is \$2.25 per cow for the 6 month period.)


