



The Ontario Appeal Court reversed a provincial Supreme Court decision last week and ordered 73-year-old Mrs. Ethel M. English of Nanaimo, B. C., to return \$50,000 allegedly bequeathed her by Lester E. Wearer, who died in 1960, aged 81. Mrs. English was Mr Weaver's housekeeper from 1951 until his death. He gave her money and securities for her own retirement which she returned to the trust company handling his \$400,000 estate at an official's request.
