



We told you last week we wouldn't want to leave Golden, B.C. and that is a fact. During our stay at the Golden Inn we became acquainted with the proprietor and he turned out to be quite a fellow. In fact, he wanted us to accompany him on a helicopter trip in search of mountain goats. This, we'd admit, could be quite an exciting adventure. However, we'd successfully navigated the twists and turns of the mountain highway for fifty miles before reaching his establishment and our luck. Consequently, after seeing him off in the helicopter we set our sights for Revelstoke. B.C. with the assurance the journey would be most exciting. It was.

Our journey today has taken us from Golden to Hope, B.C. and without a doubt the section between Golden and Revelstoke is the most fascinating. Moving on from Revelstoke we decided to travel through the Okanagan Valley rather than take the Fraser River route through Kamloops and the Hell's Gate Canyon. We're sorry now we did this. The Okanagan Valley could be a marvelous route to take under normal circumstances. However, they haven't had rain in this section since the 6th of July and it is beginning to look like the desert.

After passing through the three main towns of the Valley, namely, Vernon, Kelowna and Penticton we took a short cut over to Keremes and thence on to Hope. This part of the route we would not have wanted to miss because we saw the slide that took the lives of four people on January 9th, 1965. It is awe inspiring to see what can happen when the side of a mountain gives way. The slide let go and moved to the other side of the Valley, perhaps a mile, ran up the other side of the mountain and then settled back in the Valley. **FIRE WARNING TO MOTHERS**

One of the most destructive fire hazards in Ontario homes are the careless use and storage of inflammable liquids, and the ignition of cooking fats and oils.
