



Being hit in the eye by a champagne cork is no slight injury, says The Medical Post. It reports the findings of a group of London doctors who. after seeing eight such cases (four of them professional waiters or waitresses), have estimated that a cork from a bottle on bubbly travels at a speed of 45 feet a second, enough to send it 40 feet in the air. The one-ounce champagne cork with its lead shield can thus travel the to feet from bottle to eye in one-twentieth of a second and as the blink reflex takes one-tenth of a second the corea can receive the full impact. The London doctors say many of these injuries could be avoided by the simple trick of holding a napkin over the cork while the wire retainer is being undone. The bottle should be pointed away from all nearby faces, including that of the uncorker. There was no suggestion that people should give up drinking champagne.

Like a stitch in time, early treatment of high blood pressure can prevent serious damage later on the Ontario Heart Foundation says.
