OOoA new Policy, 'Field Enlarge ment By Fence Row Removal'', has been announced. Under this Policy, the ARDA Branch of the Outario Department of Agriculture and Food will pay 40 percent of the cost of approved fence row removal for field enlargement up to a maximum of \$500 subsidy on a farm of 100 acres of land or fraction thereof. This includes the cost of heavy equipment required to remove stones, trees and brush. This assistance is exclusive of the owner's own labour or machinery. At completion of the work, application is made showing a detailed statement of expenditures a long with receipted accounts. Application forms are available at the local Department of Agriculture and Food office. This Policy is effective to March 31, 1967.
