## OPP REPORT

The strength of the Cayuga Detachment was increased with the addition of Constable J. HANES who was recently transferred from Niagara Falls Detachment. Constable HANES has 14 years experience having been posted at Niagara Falls since his appointment to the Force. Constable HANES is married with two children and expects to take up residence in the area as soon as he can find suitable accommodation. He is a native of the Ottawa area. Total strength of the Cayuga Detachment is now 27 officers.

August 10-16, 1969 — Officers of this Detachment investigated a total of 18 accidents, 5 causing injuries to 5 persons. On August 10, 1969, it was learned that James HOLLIS, Buffalo, New York, had passed away as a result of an accident on July 16 in which his wife was killed. This fatality makes it 10 persons killed in auto accidents in 1969, on roads patrolled by this Detachment.

Officers patrolled a total of 5,386 miles over this period and issued 34 warnings and 26 charges to motorists for infractions of the Highway Traffic Act. Two drivers were charged with Impaired Driving. In Provincial Judges Court on August 13, 1969, 51 convictions were registered for this Detachment.

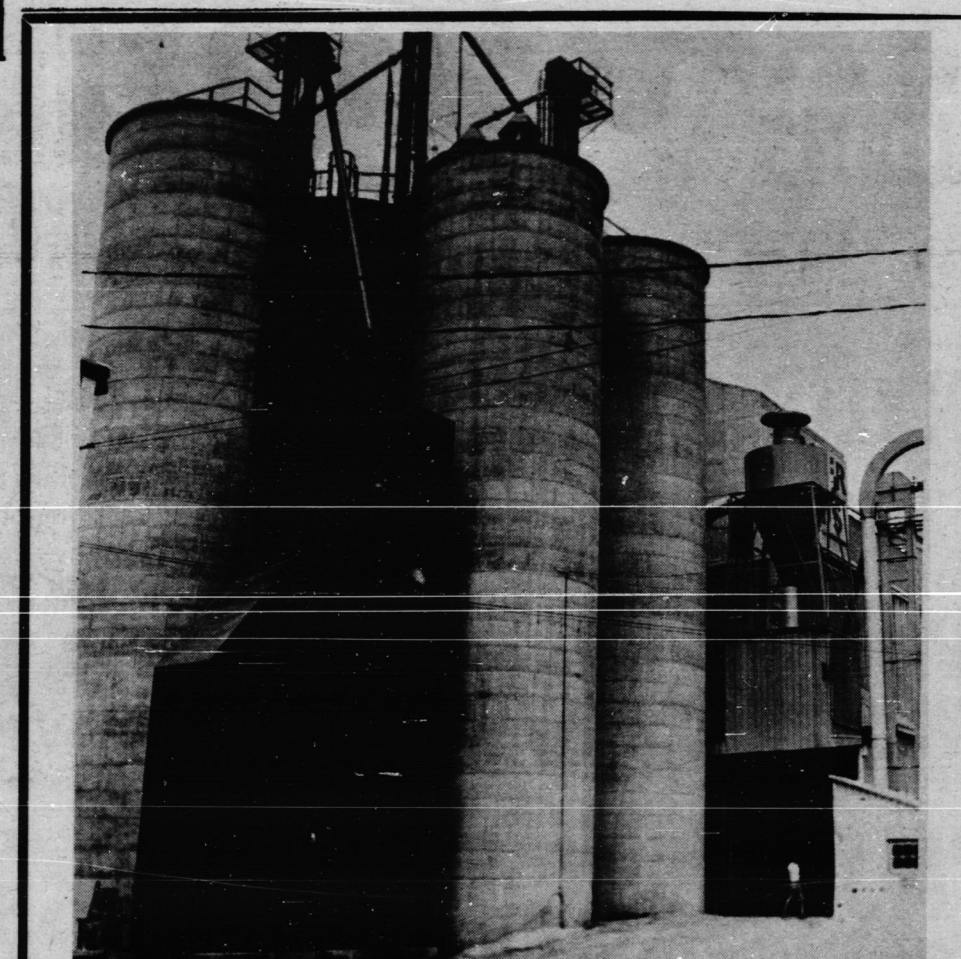
