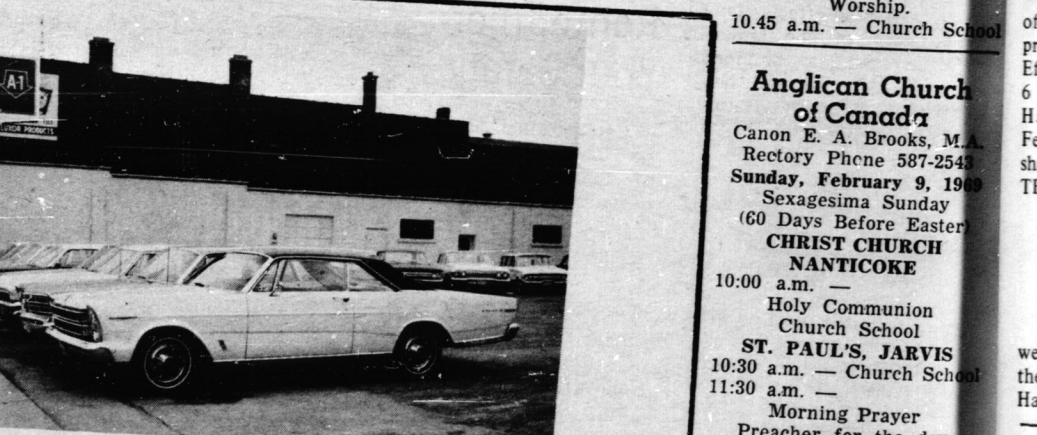

Remember Your Safety

Cold weather spell seems to have returned, which should please winter carnival promoters and the outdoor skating, skiing and hockey enthusiasts.

But it would be a good idea to renew some safety tips about rescue operations on the ice. A few moments of concentration now might save precious minutes of precious time.

And minutes, even seconds, can be precious when somebody has fallen through broken ice into freezing water. Cold water can kill.

If you're alone and fall through the ice, don't try to climb out. Instead, extend your arms over the surface of the ice, and kick as hard as possible.

This should propel you onto the ice surface and you can then roll to safety. Don't try to stand up near the area where you've fallen through. Nor should you stand up when trying to rescue someone else. You don't do any good if you fall through as well.
