### Holiday Hopes

In Edmonton the temperature has just nudged above the zero mark for the first time in three weeks; a howling winter storm is lashing the Gulf of St. Lawrence; even southern Ontario shivers in teen temperatures and blowing snowflurries. In short, it's a typical early February weather.

What matter that the days are growing perceptibly longer, that less than a month and half remains before the first official day of spring. The groundhog-regardless of his local cloud conditions-has portends six weeks more of winter.
