This Week COMING EVENTS

Harold Chamberlain, 39, of Toronto, has been charged with three counts of non-capital murder in the shooting deaths of early Christmas Day of his wife, her mother and sister.

There were four more adults and six children in the west-end Toronto home when a man kicked in the front door shortly after midnight and fired five or six bullets into three women. The others scurried for cover through doors and behind furniture.

Robina Bush, 64, and Helen Chamberlain, 32, mother of five of the children, died at the scene. Florence Brooks, 42 died later in hospital.

URGES QUIET REFORM

Ontario Education Minister William Davies said university reform can be accomplished by thinking, and not by sit-ins and marches.

In a strongly worded speech, he warned 250 student journalists of the Canadian University Press to beware of indulging in "ostentatious absencty" in seeking student rights in universities.

Mr. Davies said violence, hoodlums and obstruction only strengthen those who block the progress of democracy, who in society at large or in the university.

ISSUES WARNING touch off a provincial inquiry. A Detroit doctor who helped fight fluoride pollution in the Port Maitland, Ontario area says the threat to human health in the region, 25 miles south of Hamilton, has not yet been eliminated.

Dr. George Walcott said in a statement of inquiry, launched after the CBC documentary Air of Death was shown in 1967, investigated the health status of only nine persons living in the area, whereas 27 persons had consulted him concerning their illnesses.

Dr. Walcott appeared in the documentary which suggested that farmers were suffering from fluoride poisoning near a fertilizer plant and that cattle in the area were dying.

The report of the inquiry, contending that fluoride poisoning in the area was never a danger to human health, criticized the CBC for treating "a complex problem in a way designed to create alarm and fear."

WANT HIGHER WAGES A pressure-group of Ontario's university teachers is campaigning to win an 18-per-cent salary increase and other demands from the provincial government.

Called the Ontario Confederation of University Faculty Associations the group has prepared a brief for submission to Education Minister William Davies. Membership comprises 19 Ontario teaching associations representing about 5,500 staff.

The brief on salaries argues that faculty salaries have deteriorated since 1959-60 by 21 per cent when the rising cost of living is taken into account.
