Banks Accept UIC **Monthly Contributions** 

OTTAWA — Close to 200,000 of the 450,000 employers registered with the Unemployment Insurance Commission of Canada will soon pay their monthly contributions directly to chartered banks and certain other financial institutions, it was announced

Some institutions such as those with no commercial accounts, and some of the larger trust companies, have decided not to take part in this scheme — usually because they have little or no floating funds to cover the period when the money is in transition from their funds to the Bank of Canada. If
