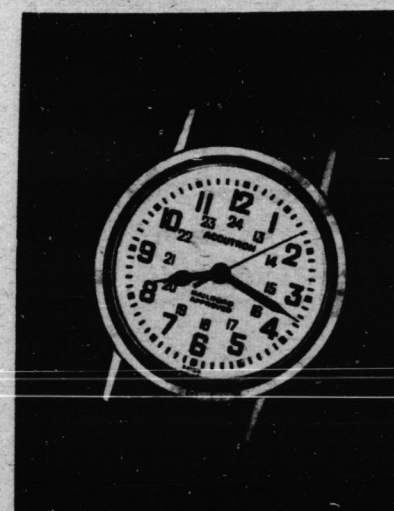

Answers Your Travel Question

Q. Are there considerable border problems usually encountered along the Inter-American Highway, such as formalities, delays or language difficulties?

A. The Hamilton Automobile Club's Travel Department reports that border crossing entails few problems or delays, but few in the heart of the Park, the officials speak English. An elementary knowledge of Spanish is handy for the traveller at such times. Some countries charge a crossing fee, the largest being \$3.50 at Honduras. Baggage checks complete inspections.

Q. Are travellers to South America, Africa and Asia actually required now to take pre-exposure immunizations against rabies?

A. The rabies immunization with a duck embryo vaccine is vigorously suggested by the Public Health Service for North Americans who plan to reside in those continents. However, it is not being recommended for tourists or short term visitors.

Q. Somewhere in Europe there is a fairly long monorail sight-seeing system that runs predominately over a beautiful river. Where is it?

A. Although there are several such systems now in operation of picturesque locales in Europe, you probably refer to the world's oldest and most popular monorail - at Wuppertal, Germany. It is more than 8 miles long, and has carried over a billion passengers since it was put into operation daily in 1901.

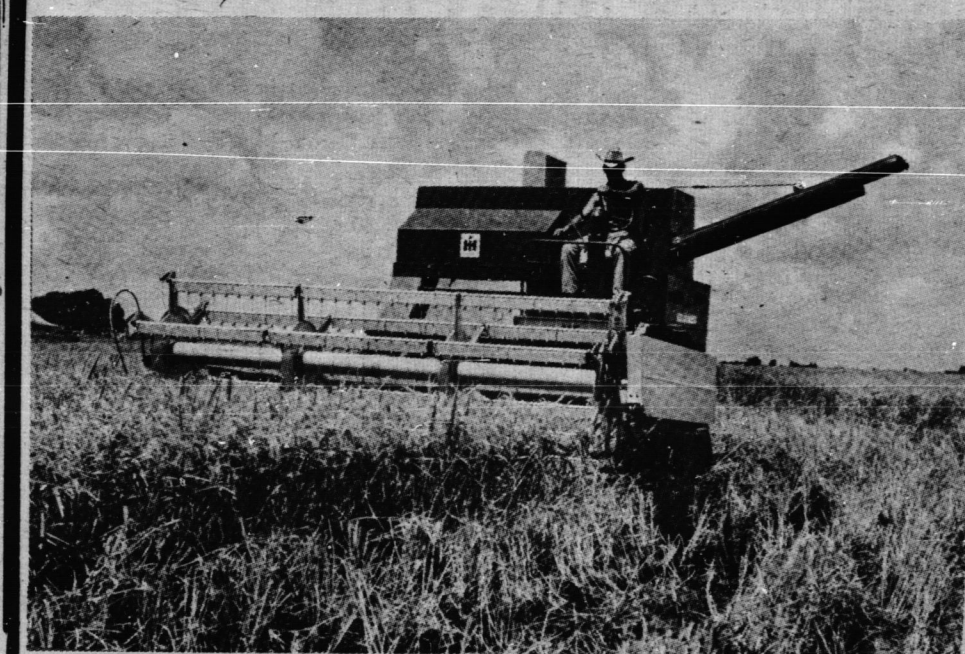
