The fifth fatal accident reported to this detachment office occurred early on May 31, 1969, on County Road no. 11 in Dunn Township causing the death of Ruth Ann BARNES of Elizabeth Crescent, Dunnville, Ontario. Prov. Const. R. Porpealia and Corporal W.J. Ambeau are in factory-trained charge of the investigation. A total of 7 persons have been fatally injured on Haldimand County Roads patrolled by this detachment, so far in 1969. A total of 10 accidents were investigate during the period of May 25-31, 1969 and 4 of these caused injuries to 5 persons.


