Road Relocations Stalled

A proposal to relocate several county roads has temporarily been stalled.

The Steel Company of Canada plans to close Norfolk County Road 6 and 3 miles of Haldimand County Road 11.

Both roads are in Stelco's 6600-acre development site

and would be replaced by a new road a mile to the north.

The Norfolk and Haldimand County roads committees have approved the proposal in principle but financial matters in Haldimand have not been resolved.

County officials say Stelco should pay the entire cost of construction where new roads are located in Stelco land, and in addition pay the county a reasonable compensation for closing Haldimand County Road 11. Ernest Craddock, Warden of Haldimand, told county council that this layout is only the beginning, as Stelco's land is capable of employing 50,000 persons.

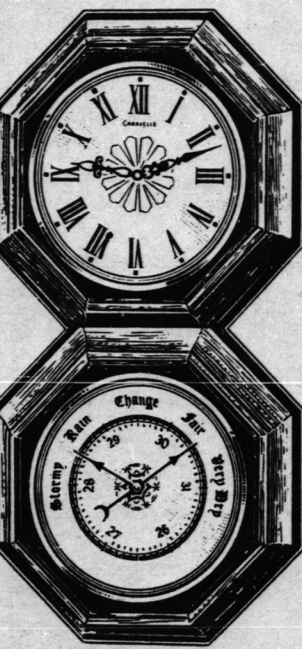
