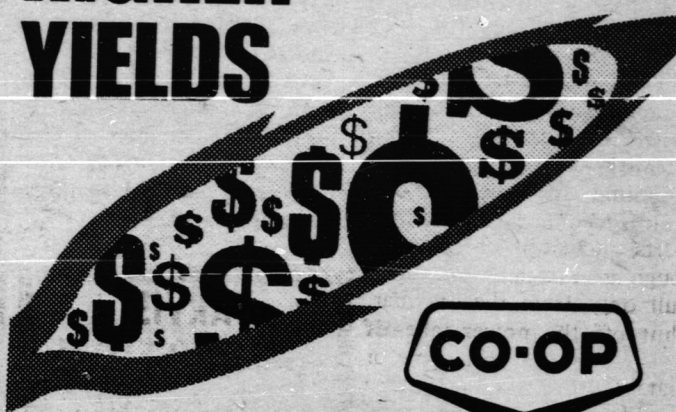

## On The Farm Front

The Ontario Milk Marketing Board has advised industrial milk shippers of a deadline May 15th for applications to enter the Group 1 Pool on a graduated basis. Those who may be wishing further information should check with in advance of the closing date.

Crop Insurance deadlines are fast approaching. All prospective applicants for insurance should be aware that there are different deadlines e.g. as we understand it, for forage crops - May 1st; for grain crops - May 15th; for corn - May 25th; and for soybeans - June 20th. Don't take these for the last word, check with your insurance agent.

Sheep producers are mostly alerted to the fact that wool sacks from the Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers' Limited are available locally from Mr. Albert Kitter, R.R. 9, Dunnville and Dwight Heisey, Selkirk.

## Zoning Change At Port Dover

The 2,000 acres of land optioned and purchased east of Port Dover by Nanticoke Development Ltd., of Toronto will remain an agricultural zone under a new holding bylaw until an official plan is submitted and the company makes formal application to have the land rezoned.

Woodhouse Reeve John Pow, said "council still has control of the use of the land under this holding bylaw. If there is an application to rezone, then council will get help from some planners."

Officials of Nanticoke Developments said Friday the land will be used for industry as well as housing, but would not say what percentage of the land would be used for which purpose.

Reeve Pow said he understood the development would be similar to Bramalea, near Toronto, which is a satellite town and an industrial park.

"We haven't heard from anyone on any matter

concerning the use of the land but we know it is big league and we, as a council will need some help if and when any application is made.

"I can't see anything happening for some time yet because it my understanding Mr. McKeough (Darcy McKeough, minister of municipal affairs) said there will be no further development planning submissions on both Haldimand and Norfolk counties."

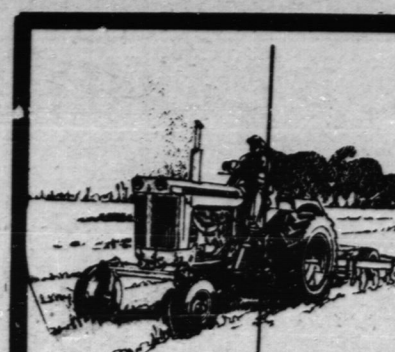

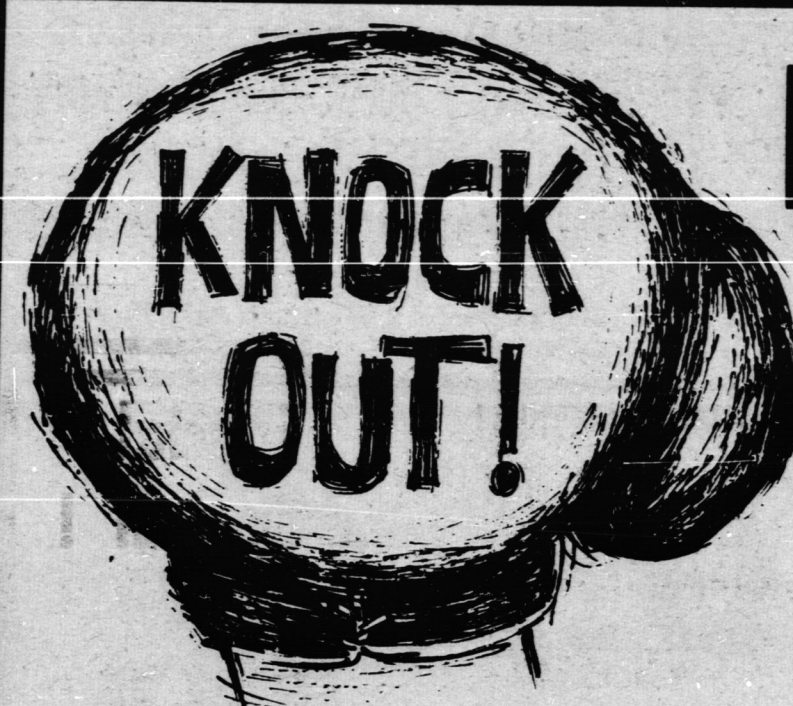
