

Governing The Sale And Setting Off Of Firecrackers, Etc. Within The Village Of Jarvis **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

No person shall fire or explode any squibs, rockets, crackers, Roman candles or other combustible fireworks in any public building, lane, alley or sidewalk or other public place within the boundaries of the Village of Jarvis, unless granted permission by the Jarvis Village Council.

No retail merchant or any other person shall sell any firecrackers, Roman candles or any combustible fireworks to any person under the age of Twenty-one years in the said

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall be liable for the first offence to a penalty of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$15.00 and for any subsequent offence to a penalty of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$25.00.
