## Teens Drop-In Centre

The Young Peoples' organization of Wesley United Church in Jarvis has, since last fall, operated a Teenage Drop-in Centre in the C.E. wing of the church. Because the village has no bowling, billiards, dancing, or other in-door recreation, this is an attempt on their part to provide for themselves, and for other young people of the

community, a place in which to meet and enjoy themselves together on a Saturday evening.

The main hall is used for badminton. Other rooms, are used for ping pong, darts and cards. In the hallway shuffle board is available, and in the back parlour, there is music, some dancing, singing, etc. Pop and chips are sold, sometimes hot dogs, coffee, hot chocolate.

The Young People have organized themselves to be responsible for setting up the facilities about 8:00 p.m., and for leaving the building clean and in good condition at the end of the evening, as well as for the general order and conduct of all the young people using the building surrounding area. 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## Ontario Hydro

Virtually everything is giant-sized at Ontario Hydro's new thermalpower station built at Nanticoke, eight miles east of Port Dover on the north shore of Lake Erie.

The 2,000,000-kilowatt plant will cost \$284 million. Preliminary work as was started in 1967 and it will take seven years to complete. The powerhouse, more than 300 yards long and 273 feet wide, will be housed in a structure 20 storeys high. By late 1971 construction forces will number 1,500.

Contract for the towering chimney, 650 feet high and costing about \$2 million has been awarded to Canadian Limited, Willowdale, to Kellogg Company, Limited, Toronto. Work has already started on the multi-flued stack, first of its type to reach this height in North America.

Danger Over-Seasoning

In Frozen Foods

When freezing, some home-prepared foods, be careful of over-seasoning before freezing, reminds the Food Council, Ontario Department of Agriculture and Food.

During freezing, some seasonings become unpleasantly strong while others lose flavor. Therefore, many authorities advise using only half the amount of seasoning called for in a recipe, adding more seasoning to taste when the dish is thawed and reheated. Pepper, garlic, onions, cloves, curry, and synthetic vanilla are seasonings that become strong and bitter or change flavor during storage. These should only be added to frozen foods when reheating.

This School Bus Safety Seminar, sponsored by the Ontario Department of Transport, is one of a series being held in centres throughout the Province. All aspects of school bus safety were covered, the laws concerning stopping for stopped school buses, safety requirements for the vehicles and their drivers, school bus patrols, rules for student passengers, and suggestions for further community efforts in this traffic safety area.

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## Don't Pick The Daisies

In a natural environment park, such as Rondeau in the Lake Erie Forest District, the department of Lands and Forests aim must be to preserve all facets of landscape with a minimum of interference.

Every year in Ontario's provincial parks visitors are found digging up plants, removing young trees or filling baskets with topsoil from the woods. They see unlimited quantities of these things and often resent any attempt to stop their activities.

They have paid a vehicle entry fee, or possibly they are leaseholders, and take the attitude that this gives them such privileges.

It is becoming more and more of a problem to preserve areas of natural landscape, and all that goes with it. With clean farming, clean and neatly graded roadsides, the felling of trees and whole woodlots, cover and consequently wildlife, is hard to find. It therefore becomes increasingly important that the natural portions of southern parks be preserved intact. This means plants - all plants, and wildlife - all species - insofar as it is possible. Management by leaving alone is perhaps the ideal course in true wilderness areas.

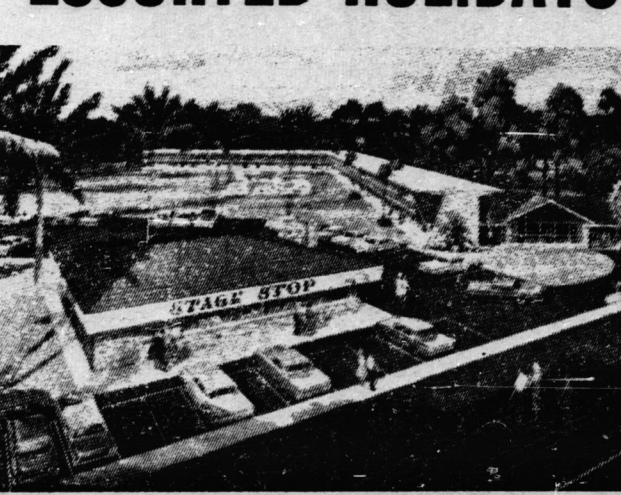
