

Coaching At H.S.S.

In any sport, coaching is a strenuous, demanding, and rewarding task. Many teachers in the community besides teaching, often take on extra-curricular coaching duties.

One such teacher and coach is John Cecchini, a senior history teacher at Hagersville Secondary School. Mr. Cecchini finds coaching football, like teaching, a great challenge.

Coaching football is a very tedious task. Every night since Labour Day no matter what the weather, Mr. Cecchini and the majority of his team practise from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.

He is usually home by six o'clock. Then he has three to four hours of work preparing lessons on the absolutism of Louis XIV, defects of Canada's taxation system, or the development of British institutions.

Football practice usually begins with 15 minutes of calisthenics, basic drills, new plays and a half-hour scrimmage.

The majority of the boys haven't missed a practice this year; as a matter of fact few of the boys stay after practice to improve their skills whether its punting or practising field goals.

Like Mr. Cecchini, the majority of the boys give the coach more than 100%. Their spirit enthusiasm, and desire seemed to have percolated throughout the rest of the student body.

Because of his coaching, making the boys obedient and responsible and finally preparing them for an important game.

But more important than the team record is the fact that over 100 boys were given an opportunity to participate in this skillful, exciting sport. Let us hope that Mr. Cecchini and his players continue to do as well in the following years.

Mr. Cecchini looks forward to going out and coaching these boys. Since football was introduced to Hagersville Secondary School two years ago, the team has come a long way from one win in 1967 to an undefeated season this year.

SIMCOE - Appointment of Gordon W. McNern as Deputy Chairman of the Recreation Centre Building Fund was announced this week by B. Wallace Anderson, Fund General Chairman.

While assisting the General Chairman in all organizational duties, Mr. McNern's principle area of operation will be organizing outside the Town of Simcoe.

Construction of the Recreation Centre and a public campaign to raise the money required to build it have been approved by Town Council and the Recreation Commission.

The Centre will contain an indoor swimming pool, arts, crafts, meeting and athletic rooms and a 550-seat theatre.

Final plans for the structure are now on the architect's drawing board and the financial objective of the appeal will be announced once the plans are completed.

The general solicitation phase of the public appeal is timed to begin in January.

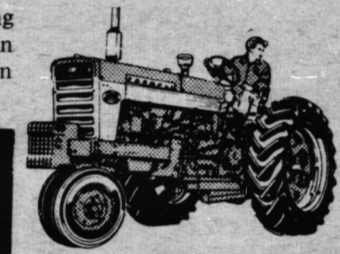
Scout Notes
