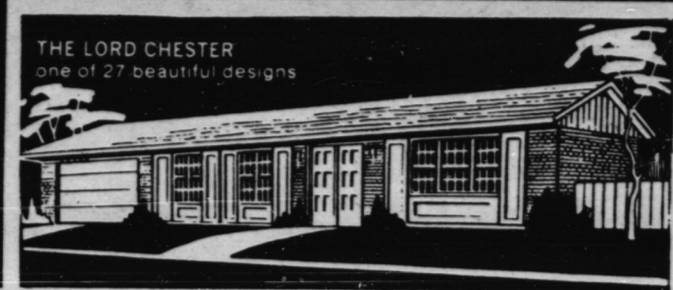

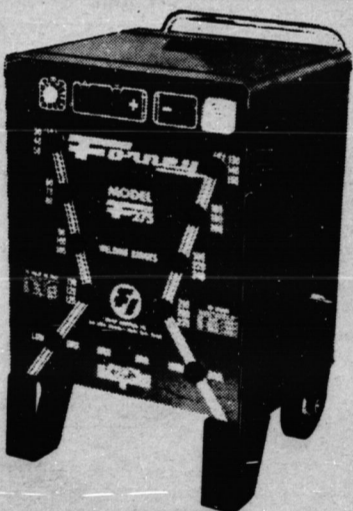

Ever since I was a boy, the little principality of Montenegro (in the Balkans) has fascinated me. This little mountain country clung fiercely to its independence and refused to submit to foreign powers, even defying the then mighty Austrian Empire.

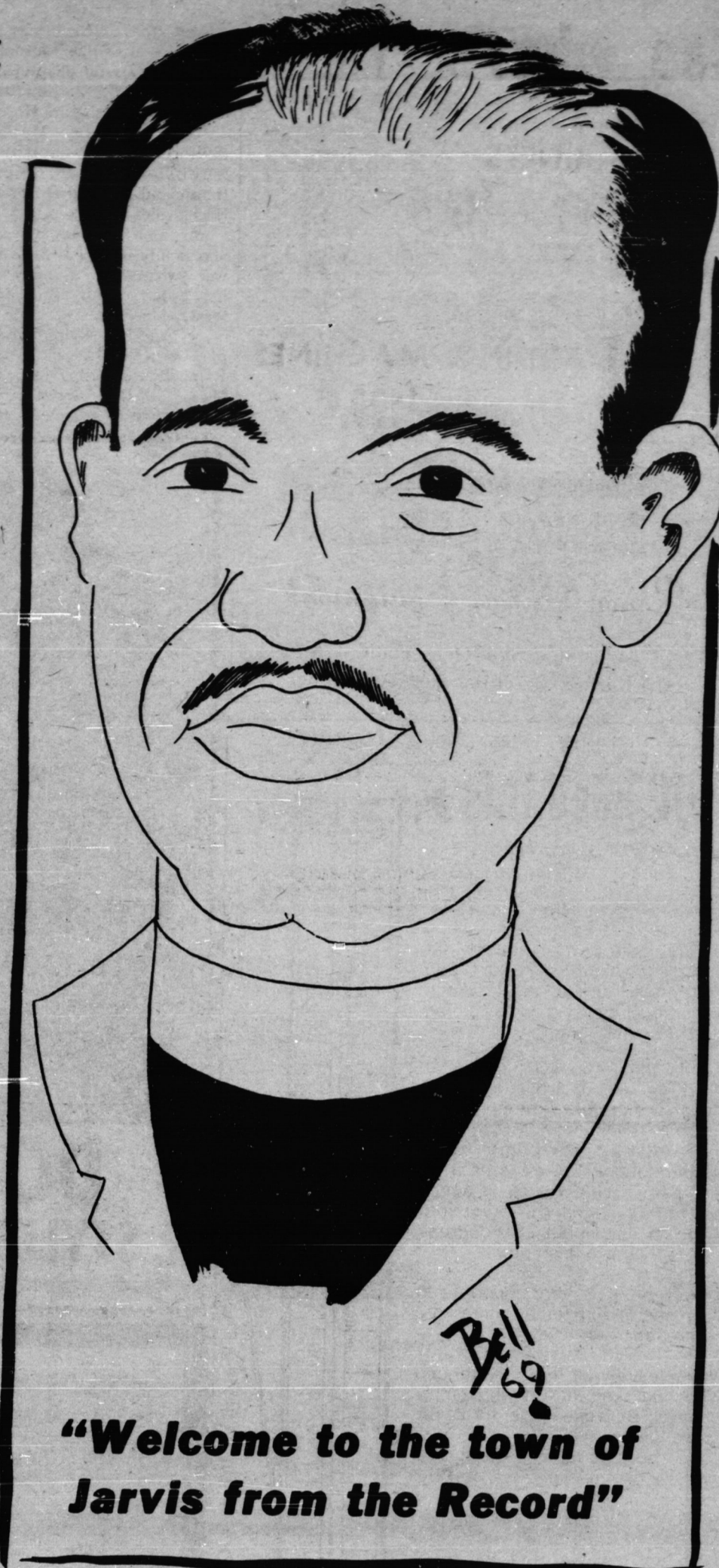

Duck Season Opens Saturday

The duck hunting season opens Saturday and runs until December 15.

The bag limit remains five ducks per day, but this season only one Redhead or one Canvasback are allowed in the daily limit. Also only four Wood Ducks may be shot per day.

After October 11, the daily bag limit may include two additional Bluebills or Goldeneyes and thus increases to a limit of seven birds if these species are included.

Hunting at the Long Point Waterfowl Management Unit will open at 11 a.m. on Saturday morning and close one hour before sunset on opening day only.

licence also may be used at the Waterfowl Management Units at Rondeau and Holiday Beach. As reservations are not accepted for the first two days of the season, a first come, first served rule applies then which causes some avid hunters to line up days in advance. Mr. Beck said the first one arrived last Thursday and while he hadn't been joined by any others yet at the first of this week, they had received lots of enquires. Following the first two days, reservations are accepted and usually there is enough accommodation to meet the demand, he added. Last year 2,000 duck hunters used the Long Point Waterfowl Management Unit facilities. Mr. Beck hopes that it will be a good season. "Right now we are feeding in the marsh and there are a lot of local ducks coming in," he observed.
