Detachment Investigates Seventeen Accidents

The Cayuga OPP Detachment investigated a total of 17 accidents over the period of Sept. 21-27. Of these, five were personal injury causing injuries to six persons.

Officers patrolled a total of 5,619 miles and issued 31 warnings and 20 charges to motorists for infractions of the Highway Traffic Act. As a result of four Liquor Control Act investigations, four persons have been charged. In St. Catharines Provincial Judge's Court on Saturday Sept. 24, 35 convictions were registered for this offence.

General occurrences reported and investigated included four thefts, eight break and enters, one assault and 16 requests for assistance. Const.

- WEINER CASSEPOLE**
3 large potatoes
salt and pepper to taste
1 lb. weiners
1 tsp. flour (sprinkle)
1/2 cup grated cheese
1 onion (sliced)
1 can cream of chicken or cream of mushroom soup
sliced tomatoes
1. Slice potatoes in bottom of casserole.
2. Add seasonings and flour.
3. Cut weiners in 1/2 inch pieces and add to dish.
4. Sprinkle with cheese and add onion.
5. Pour soup over all and top with sliced tomatoes. (Sprinkle with more grated cheese if you wish).
6. Bake at 350 for 1 1/2 hours.
7. Serves four.
