## Crimes Of Non-Violence

Counterfeit cheques which closely resemble Ontario Hydro pay cheques have been passed recently in banks and chain stores in the Ottawa, London, Hamilton and Toronto areas. Likewise, Government of Canada cheques have also been counterfeited, passed and not discovered until they return to their respective Departments.

During the past year, Officers of the Ontario Provincial Police Anti-Rackets Branch and the Metropolitan Toronto Police Fraud Squad, in conjunction with police departments across Canada, have been investigating this type of crime.

While it is difficult to prevent the counterfeiting of cheque forms, it is not impossible to prevent the criminal element from PERSONAL CHEQUES cashing them.

There are several precautions which citizens in all walks of life may take to prevent the forger from obtaining his objective.

1. IDENTIFICATION - If the passer is not personally known, insist on several items of identification. If the cheque is already endorsed, have the passer sign it again in your presence.
2. DO NOT ASSUME - Skilled cheque passers often dress the part. A construction "hard hat" worn with work clothes does not necessarily mean what is being conveyed. The woman with the child may not be what she seems. The old-age pensioner may be a ruse. The suave, well-dressed businessman could be a fake, as well as his cheque.
3. DELAY - Cheque passers like to work fast. Delay makes them nervous. If in doubt, double-check identification.

Company executives should keep their company cheque forms and cheque writers locked in a safe place. A break-in could put them in the hands of the forger.

Thefts from the mail before delivery are increasing. Street letter boxes are being uprooted and stolen intact; they are also being opened with forged keys right on location.

Once in possession of your mailed cheque, the forger fraudulently uses your signature and bank account number to defraud banks and businesses.

Simple precautions will help in controlling this type of crime.

1. When possible, deposit your mail at your local post office, or
2. Deposit your mail in a street letter box just before final collection times.
3. Keep a record of cheques issued and have your bank account made up regularly.
4. Report discrepancies immediately.

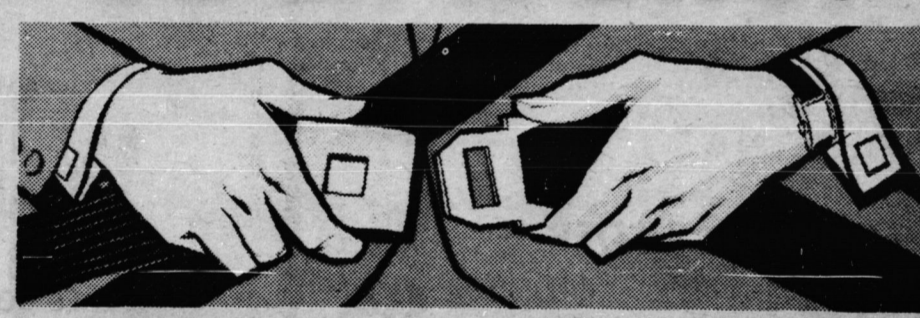

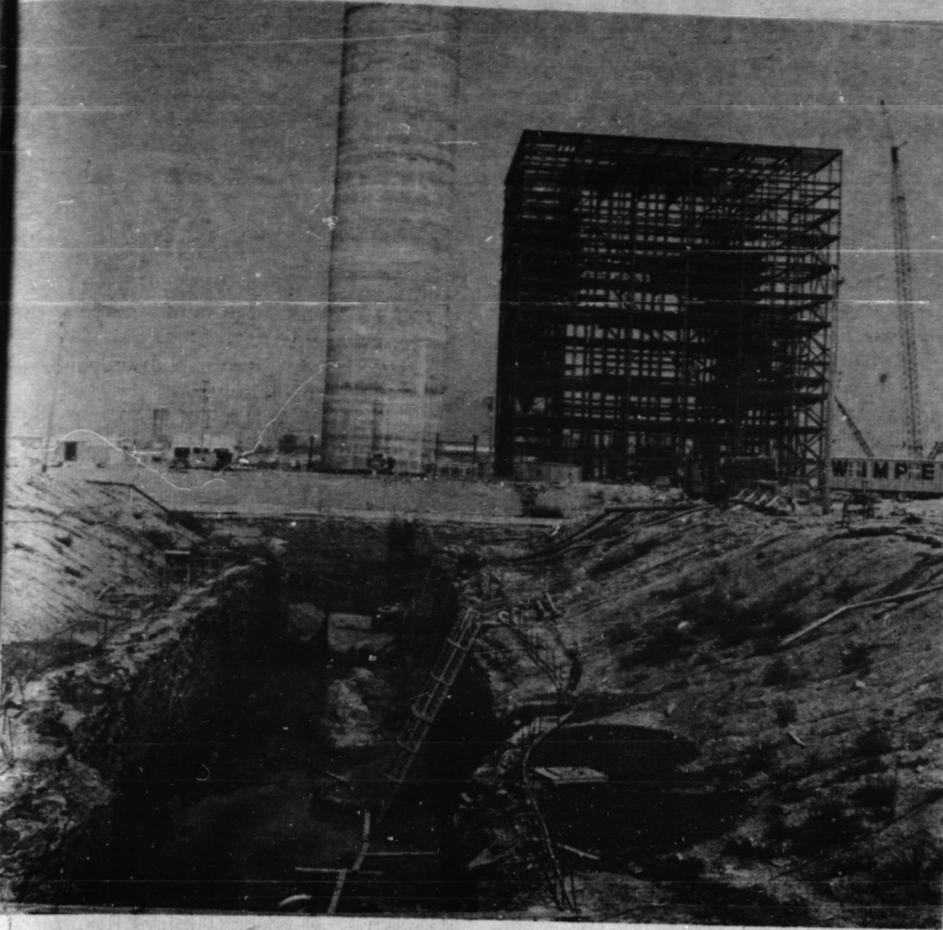

## Stiffer Penalties For Speeding

A sliding scale of fines for speeding convictions, with the penalty rising sharply in relation to the speed, goes into effect in Ontario on September 1, 1969.

Under the new sliding scale, the fine will rise with the speed: \$2 for each mile per hour over the speed limit up to 9 m.p.h.; \$3 per mile between 10 and 19 m.p.h. over the limit; \$4 per mile between 20 and 29 m.p.h. over the limit; and \$5 per mile for 30 m.p.h. over the limit.

For an offence that occurs after September 1, a driver will be fined \$10 for driving 5 m.p.h. in a 30 m.p.h. zone. But that fine will rise to \$30 if he is convicted of driving 40 m.p.h. in the same zone and to \$150 if he is driving 60 m.p.h.

A new sliding scale of fines as also been set for convictions resulting from the overloading of commercial vehicles.

Changes in fines make up the bulk of more than 60 amendments to the Ontario Highway Traffic Act which Transport said. "New become effective September 1."

"We have overhauled the entire system of deterrents by discarding the principle of varying fines for first, second and third or subsequent offences," Hon. Irwin shocking disrespect for the Haskett, Ontario's Minister of traffic laws.
