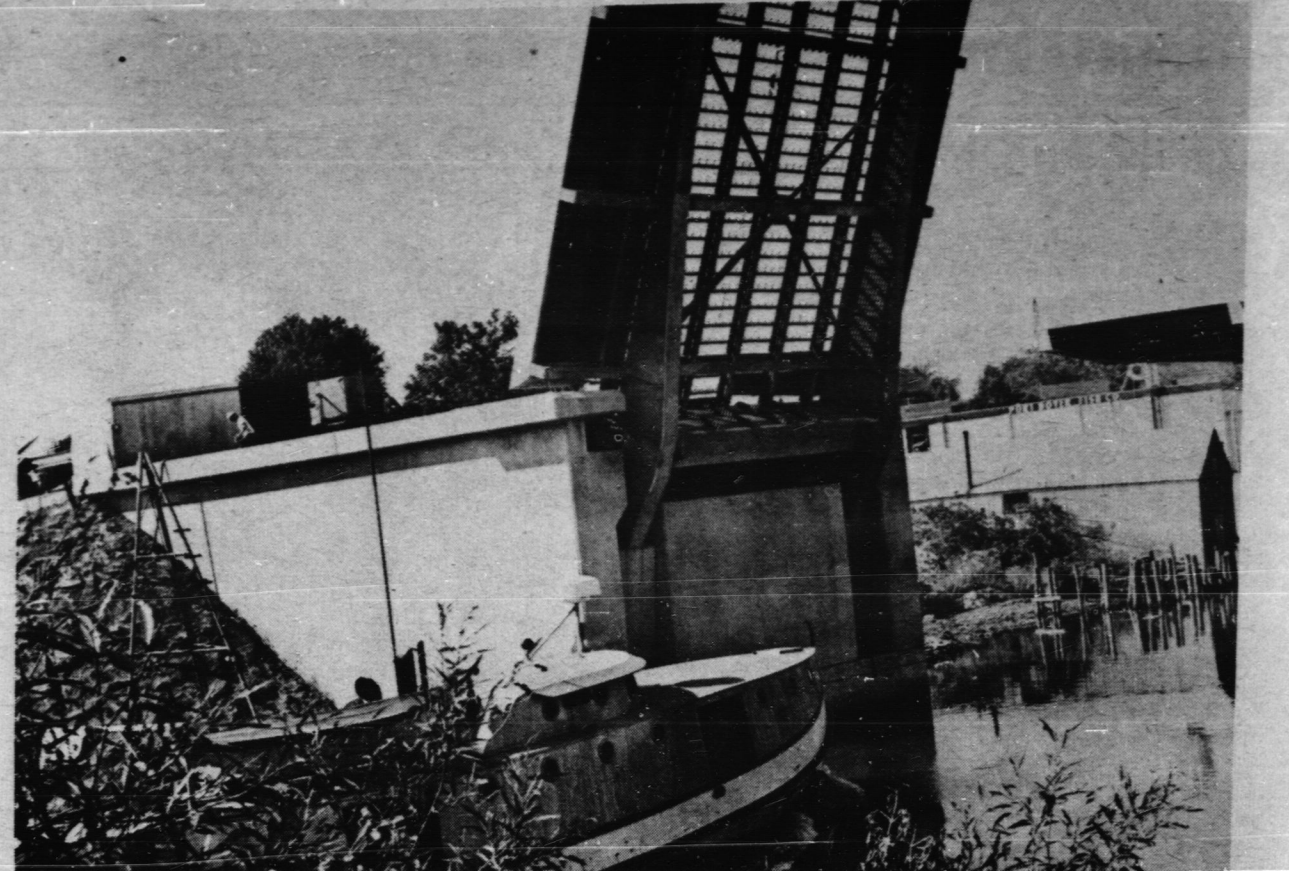

**New Regulations For Passports**  
Passport application forms incorporating new regulations which went into effect in January are now available in post offices across the country, the external affairs department announced Monday.  
Formerly passports were issued for five years for a fee of \$5 and were renewable for another five years for \$2.  
The new regulations raise the fee to \$10 and drop the renewal provision.  
A statement by External Affairs Minister Mitchell Sharp, when the new regulations went into effect Jan. 22, said they were "aimed at strengthening the security of the Canadian passport."
