We have examined the records of the Corporation of the Village of Jarvis, the Hydro-Electric System, the Water and Sewerage System, and the Community Centre Board for the year ended December 31, 1969 and have prepared the following statements:

Statement 1 — Revenue Fund and Capital Fund Balance Sheet.  
Statement 2 — Statement of Revenue and Expenditure.

The year's operations resulted in a surplus of \$15,838.49. This surplus for the year together with the balance of surplus at the beginning of the year of \$15,760.63 amounts to an accumulated surplus of \$31,599.12.

Taxes in arrears at December 31, 1969 amount to \$10,210.08 an increase of \$509.69 from same time last year. Collections of 1969 taxes amounted to 93.06% of the roll.

We report that in our opinion:

- (1) The financial transactions which have come under our notice have been within the powers of the municipality.
- (2) The audit has been conducted in accordance with the instructions of the Department of Municipal Affairs.
- (3) The financial statements present fairly the financial position of the municipality as at December 31, 1969 and the results of its operations for the year ended on that date.
