Fresh vegetables are back on the table again, and there are interesting ways to combine with other things. The Canada department of agriculture suggests using asparagus in open-face

One way is to combine it with cheese. You need: 1 pound asparagus, 12 slices buttered bread, 12 slices Motorcycles. Bake at 350 until custard is set (about

45 minutes). Serves six. With Beef: Asparagus beef sandwiches call for - 1 pound minced beef, 4 hamburger buns split and toasted, butter, prepared mustard (optional), salt, and pepper, 1 pound cooked asparagus, 8 slices process

cheddar cheese. Form beef into 8 patties and broil until medium rare. Spread buns with butter and prepared mustard. Place a beef patty on each half bun and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Cut asparagus spears in halves and arrange a few spears on each patty. Top with a slice of cheese and broil until cheese melts

(about 2 minutes). Makes 8 Bake Mushrooms: For a different way with mushrooms you need - 11/2 pounds mushrooms, ¼ cup

butter, ½ teaspoon salt. Wash and remove tough parts of stem. Slice lengthwies. Add mushrooms to greased 1½-quart casserole. Sprinkle with salt, dot with butter. Cover and bake at 325 degrees for 90 minutes, 375 for an hour, 425 for 35 to 40 minutes. Remove cover at half time

To serve a mushroom carrot medley, you need: 12 medium carrots, 1 sliced mushrooms, ½ cup diced green pepper, ¼ cup melted butter, 2 tablespoons chopped parsley, 1 tablespoon lemon uice, ¼ teaspoon salt, ¼

Cut carrots in halves lengthwise. Cook until just tender (about 15 minutes).

Saute mushrooms and green pepper in butter 5 to minutes. Add parsley, lemon juice and seasonings. Sprinkle misture over hot drained carrots. Makes 6
