Adolescents Investigated

SASKATOON (CP) — The University of Saskatchewan will begin a five year study early in the new year to investigate basic mental function development in adolescents.

Between 300 and 400 grade 8 students, all 13 years old, will take part in the study. A pilot study of 36 students is nearing completion.

Directing the research are Dr. Gordon Margerison and Aldred Neufeldt of the university staff.

They say the adolescent period, characterized by rapid changes, is a poorly understood phase of human development.

Once a year for the next five years, the brain impulses of the students will be recorded by an electroencephalograph which provides information on brain function. Modes of perception, thinking and memory also will be checked in a series of special exercises.

The researchers say they hope to obtain a clearer picture of normal psychological growth during a period when the brain is developing rapidly.

The special exercises will be correlated with the brain analyses to give information on visual and auditory memory, strategies used to aid memory, the use of imagery and the extent to which a person relies on reference points to operate in a given field of vision.

Both doctors have received grants from the Medical Research Council of Canada. The students, selected from Saskatoon schools, are paid volunteers.
