Credit Information Invasion of Privacy

The Advisory Branch of the Policy Research Council of the Ontario Young Progressive Conservative Association in a brief to Attorney General, Arthur Wishart and Financial and Commercial Affairs Minister, Leslie Rowntree have called for provincial legislation to license all consumer credit companies in Ontario.  
The brief suggests a "Code of Ethics" governing Associated Credit Bureaus to be incorporated in legislation and outlining minimum requirements for conduct throughout the industry.  
The Young Progressive Conservatives also want the individual to have the opportunity to inspect and contest credit data and to prohibit its disclosure.  
The brief states "Prior to any disclosure of credit information, the opportunity to inspect and contest the data on file should be afforded the subject and his consent to such disclosure must be obtained. Further, everyone should have this right to inspect and contest at any time, not only when applying for credit.  
They recommend that a

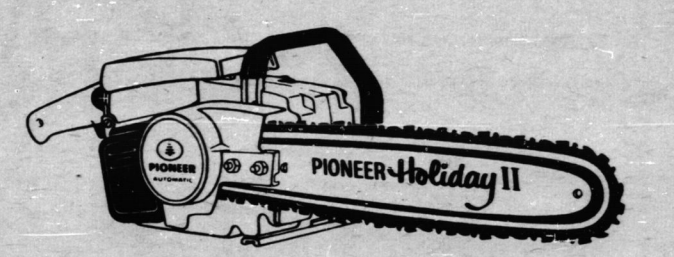
