Pull Over For Flashing Light Or Siren

How often have you seen an ambulance caught up in traffic, despite the fact that

it's on an emergency run? Incidents like this are far too common, and it was for this reason a new amendment was introduced stipulates that drivers must right-hand side of the road as possible when an ambulance, fire or police vehicle is flashing a red light on the roof. Previously, this was only required when a bell or siren was operating.

aimed at ensuring that no driver can ignore an emergency vehicle under the pretext that he did not hear the siren because of his car radio, or other distracting noise inside the car. There is a fine for failing to pull off to the right-hand side of the roadway for an emergency vehicle. Under the general penalties section of the Highway Traffic Act, it can range from \$20 to \$100. according to the new scale
