Dear Mr. Martin: I am going to get married soon and would like to know whether I'd be better off renting an apartment at first or buying a home right away. Can you help me? Mr. E. B. H.

Dear Mr. E. B. H.: To most families, their home is their biggest single investment, so careful planning is called for before you decide to purchase. A major feature of the Amendment extends subdivision control and part-lot control over all lands in Ontario.

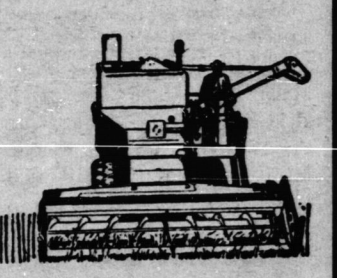
This measure is designed to encourage the orderly use of lands and to help our communities meet land-use requirements for education, housing, pollution and other purposes.

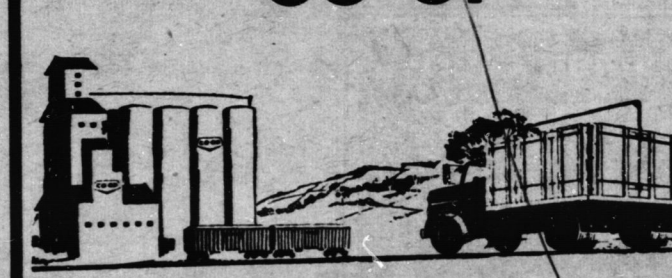
