His intention was to reside there, as both land and water were bountiful in providing the necessaries of life, ducks, ruffed grouse, woodcock, snipe and deer were plentiful, also fish in endless supply. This he told me - he was my great uncle. I had many talks with him as a grown boy. Not many men can now say that

they have talked with a man who tried to shoot George Washington. But Joseph Ryerson was a noted young New Jersey sniper from 1776 to 1783. He died aged 93. He was the grandfather of the present Surgeon--General Ryerson, of Red Cross fame, and father of Egerton Ryerson hereinafter mentioned. We first begin to hear of
