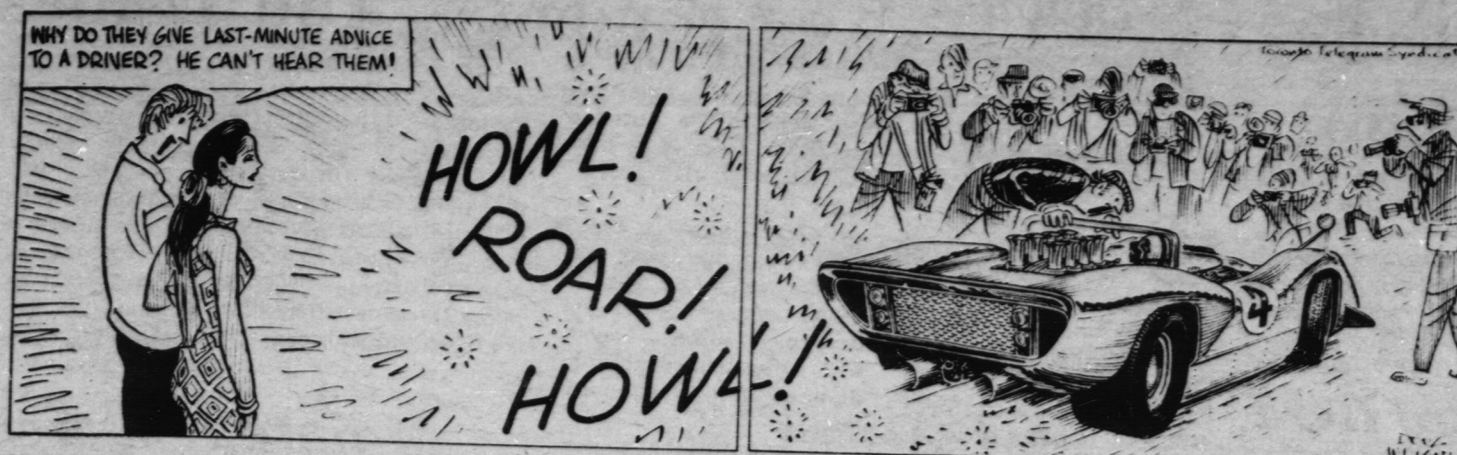

### Former Resident Advances

A well known broadcaster, whose face was well-known on the CBC's National Television News, and who, over the last 18-months has become, "the face of the English-speaking Canadian", in Montreal is returning to Ontario.

Jack Oldham, the son-in-law of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Cooke, of Jarvis, has accepted an appointment with the Canada Trust Company, Huron & Erie Mortgage Corporation. He became manager of Public Relations for Canada's third largest trust company at their head office in London, as of July 1.

A native of England, Mr. Oldham came to Canada in 1955, when a strike closed down his newspaper, the Sunday Chronicle, after nearly 200 years of publication. Five years later, in 1960 Mr. Oldham became a Canadian Citizen. Ten years ago he married Ruthann Miller of Jarvis at the Jarvis United Church. They have four sons, the eldest aged seven and one years and one born 10 months ago in Montreal.

Mr. Oldham has been in the news business for most of his career, apart from a stint as a Commissioned Officer with the British Intelligence Corps toward the end of the Second World War when he left University. He was at Manchester and then Oxford and did two years

medical school before finally choosing journalism.

In Canada Mr. Oldham has been almost exclusively in broadcasting as an interviewer, panalist, a producer and as a managing editor of the CBC's National Television News in Toronto for nine years. He has also appeared in Public Affairs Shows in the United States

and is a personal friend and colleague of Patrick Watson and Laurie Lapierre. Jack Oldham went to Montreal 18 months ago to study "the French fact", and became the Deputy Director of News and Public Affairs, Radio and Television for Canada's oldest broadcaster, the Marconi Company of Canada at CFCF, Montreal.

PROGRAM HONORED TORONTO (CP) — An Ontario education department television program for secondary school students has been awarded honorable mention in an international competition. The program, What Do I Like About Tommy? was entered in the Prix Jeunesse International 1970 in Munich, Germany, in July. It centered on problems of the maturing adolescent in the family structure.

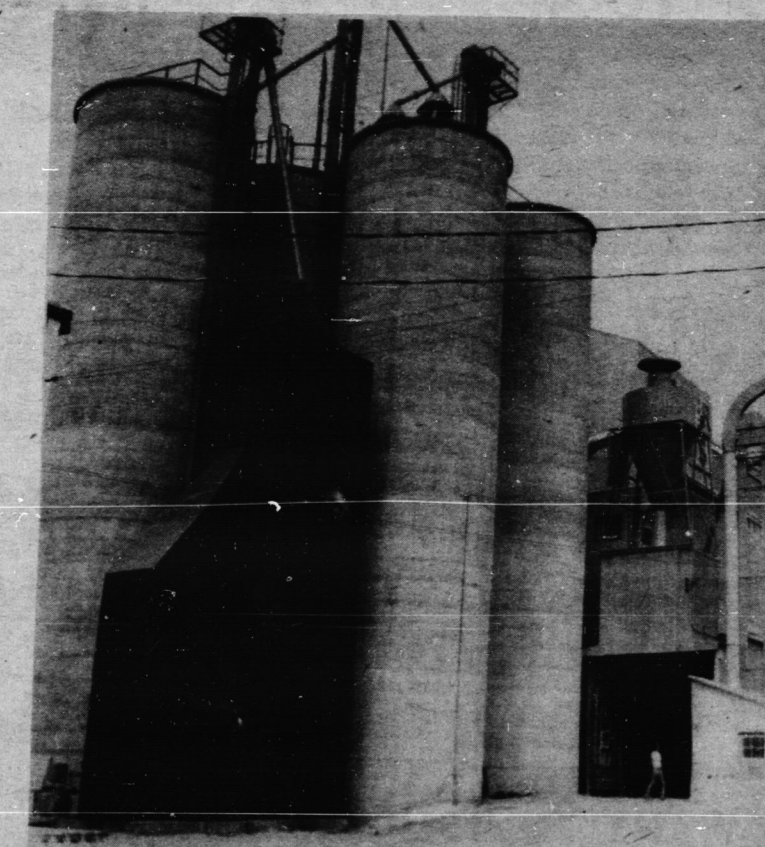
