Special Weed Garden Aids In Identification

Weeds are a common problem in gardens and lawns, and trying to control them is often made difficult because many weed varieties are hard to identify.

This identification problem may now be rectified for many gardeners if a project started by Dr. J.F. Alex, Department of Botany, University of

Guelph, catches on elsewhere. On a plot of land at the University, Dr. Alex has collected 220 common lawn weeds and allowed them to grow to full maturity. Beside the weed plot is a control square of mowed lawn where the weeds can be seen in their immature state.
