Teatime Topics

There is a variety of herb seeds available - poppy, sesame, anise, fennel caraway, dill, celery. They can be used, whole of ground, with a lot of foods to give them a different touch. The Canadian Spice Association has some

Anise seed has a licorice flavor and may be used whole or crushed in applesauce, beef stew. stewed fruits, appetizers and sea food In a coffee-cake mix, use

about ¼ teaspoon. Sprinkle 1 tablespoon over the tops of a dozen cupcakes. For five dozen cookies, One 1/8 teaspoon celery seed in 4 cups of potato

salad, 1 teaspoon. You may use caraway seed in biscuits, waffles, potatoes, cookies, seasoned butter, meat marinades,

coleslaw and chowders. Use it sparingly. Add ¼ teaspoon to 8 ounces of cooked noodles, 1 teaspoon to 3 cups of

potato salad, 1 teaspoon in vinegar for 2 cups of sliced cucumbers, 1 teaspoon to 2 cups batter for cornbread or Celery seed in the dried

seed of a wild variety of celery. Celery salt is a combination of ground celery seed and salt Une 1/8 teaspoon celery

seed in 4 cups of potato salad, 1 teaspoon in 11/2 cups French or other salad dressing, 1 teaspoon in 2 tablespoons butter for hot bread or muffins, a dash in chilled tomato juice.

Dill seed has a pungent, aromatic flavor in salads. sauerkraut, stew, rolls. cottage cheese, dill pickles and pickled beets.

In a pound of ground beef try ½ teaspoon crushed seed, ¼ teaspoon

crushed in 2 tablespoons butter for seasoning fish fillets or hot vegetables

Fennel seed also has a slight licorice taste. You can add it to boiling water for failry strong tasting vegetables such as cauliflower, brussels sprouts

Try ¼ teaspoon sprinkled on a 4 pound roast of pork, 1/8 teaspoon in 3 cups of potato salad, 1/8 teaspoon in water for cooking 1 pound of shrimp.

The poppy seed, perhaps the most familiar herb seed, may be used for more than topping rolls.

Put 1 teaspoon in mix for dozen corn muffins, 2 tablespoons in cookie batter using 3 cups of flour, 1 teaspoon in 1/4 cup melted butter stirred into 8 ounces of cooked noodles.

Sesame seed may be used in rolls, pie crusts, candies, dips, casseroles, salads and cheese spreads. Use 1 tablespoon
