A Word To The Wise

To ensure the greatest leasure for all who wish to use Ontario's Provincial Parks, we would like to pass on a few rules and tips that will benefit everyone.

Parks are fragile things Plants, animals, natural and historic objects, and facilities are here for all to enjoy, and regulations protecting them against abuse are meant to ensure your pleasure. You will enjoy your visit more if you know that you will be leaving the park just as beautiful and unspoiled as you found it.

Dogs and cats are permitted in parks, but they are not allowed in beach areas, and they must be kept on a short leash at all

Campfires for cooking and obtaining warmth are permitted. We ask that visitors use the fireplaces in the areas where they are installed, and also warn them that all fires must be extinguished before they are

regulations of the Department of Transport, unattended except at designated place under authority of a lease, agreement, regulation or campsite permit.

Campsite permits are required to camp in campgrounds, and camping outside of them is not allowed unless the camper is two miles away from a public road and possesses an interior camping permit. Campers may camp for a total of 28 days in a Provincial Park.
