\$55,846. Dunville will pay the biggest part of the county levy at \$146,423 or 15.9 per cent. Walpole is next with \$143,602 or 15.6 per cent. The smallest contributor is Jarvis with \$16,101.

Dr. Washburn told council the Haldimand dental program to be introduced this fall will reduce children's cavities as well as save parents many trips to the dentist.

Dr. Washburn told council the \$28,000 tab presented for the program was incorrect.

He said the tab for the program is \$39,000 of which government grants will pay 50 per cent and Haldimand-Norfolk share will be \$19,500. Since the program won't start until September Haldimand residents will only pay \$2,300 this year.

"Dentists say that to explain preventative care to parents individually in their offices is a lost cause but under the school program whole classrooms can be treated simultaneously at no direct charge.

"It is better to get a \$2 fluoride application at school than a \$10 treatment at the dentist's", said Dr. Washburn.

He emphasized that the decay rate has been substantially decreased in other areas by using this program.

Haldimand-Norfolk will share the cost of a dentist at a salary of \$8,500, a hygienist at \$4,100 and an assistant at \$1,750.

The program has to also be approved by the provincial government. Dr. Washburn said Haldimand-Norfolk were high on the priority list.

Menu Of Week

Sausage with Polenta, Crispy Potato Slices, Mashed Turnips, Fresh Pear Halves.

Thrifty budget suggestions from the Ontario Food Council, Ontario Department of Agriculture and food, include tasty cornmeal topped with brown-and-serve sausages in a tomato sauce, plus savory fried potatoes and nutritious vitamin C-packed turnips.

For fresh fruit at mealtime, serve tender, juicy pears, alone or with a sauce. Supplies are getting lighter but these are still available at good prices.

Sausage with Polenta: 1 lb. pork or beef sausage; 1 tbs. salad oil; 1 large onion, chopped; 28 oz. can tomatoes; 6-oz. can tomato paste; 1 tsp. sugar; 1 tbs. parsley, chopped; 1/2 tsp. dry mustard; 1/2 tsp. sweet basil.

Polenta: 3/4 cup cornmeal; 2 cups milk; 1 egg; 1/2 cups Parmesan; 2 tbs. butter; 1 tsp. salt; 1/8 tsp. black pepper.
