**Adult Night School For Haldimand County**

CAYUGA ONT. - The Haldimand County Board of Education will be offering adult night school courses at the Four Secondary Schools during the school year 1970-1971.

To improve and upgrade our present educational standards we are prepared to offer a variety of technical, commercial and academic courses.
